

**ORDINANCE # 500-002**  
**AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE EXCLUSION OF MINORS UNDER AGE OF EIGHTEEN**  
**YEARS FROM PLACES INJURIOUS TO MORALS**

The City Council of the City of Hewitt does ordain as follows

SECTION 1: Whoever admits any minor person under the age of eighteen years or suffers such person to remain in any place, after 10:00 p.m., where alcohol is served, unless such person under age of eighteen years is accompanied by his parent, or guardian, or legal custodian, or having a written permit from his parent, guardian or legal custodian, so to do, shall be punished as hereinafter provided.

SECTION 2: Every minor person under the age of eighteen years is hereby prohibited from remaining in any establishment where alcohol is served, after 10:00 p.m. unless he is accompanied by or has a written permit from his parent, guardian or legal custodian, except as specifically for in Minnesota Statutes 340A.503, 340A.509 and/or 340A.412.

SECTION 3: Any person violating any of the provisions of this chapter, shall upon conviction thereof, be subject to penalty as set forth in #100-004.

SECTION 4: This chapter shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication.
